2. **WAC Overview:** Ann
 - WAC supports all 22 sports at Wash- our goal is to raise money for the Activities Department, where the funds can be distributed as needed by the AD
 - This has been a challenging year as we have not been able to do some of our traditional events, so we are brainstorming new ways to raise money; Shawn had a couple suggestions:
 - Golf Outing this fall- would be a safe way to connect people and raise money; with further discussion, we decided not to pursue this at this time
 - Cookie Walk/Drive Thru- set up cookies and milk or hot cocoa at 4-5 houses in a neighborhood- people could walk or drive to each house and for a free will donation, they would get cookies and a drink- target date is December 10th- Bree Robinson, Shawn & Jackie Bergquist will co-chair this new event
3. **AD Report:** Grant
 - Update on building repairs- scheduled to be completed on November 2nd with student returning on November 16th
 - The plan is to move ahead with Winter sports and the state is current working on guidelines
 - Fall season winding down-
 - Men's Golf- Nile Petersen and Andrew Freeman were each medalists at 18 hole tournaments this year
