

# WAC Meeting

## December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020

### 1) Minutes from November

- Teresa Pakulis made a motion to approve; seconded by Andrea Lewerenz-Norris; approved

### 2) AD Report- Grant Schultz

- Building reopened to students and winter sports are practicing
- Congratulations to Watts McBride for receiving All State honors in football- 3<sup>rd</sup> team Iowa Press Sports Writers association and Honorable Mention Des Moines Register
- JV2 Women's basketball is cancelled due to low number of participants
- There will be spectator limits at Winter Activities:
  - Basketball- 2 per player & can only stay for game their kid is playing in
  - Cheerleaders, Dance team, and Coaches- 2 per player
  - Wrestling- 2 per wrestler
  - Swimming- 2 per swimmer
  - Bowling- 1 per bowler

- There will be live streaming of as many varsity events as possible
- Jr. Warrior basketball and volleyball tournaments may not happen this year- the CRCSD is not allowing outside groups to use our facility
- Hall of Fame- a decision will be made in early January if this event will be postponed until next year or possibly do a virtual event

### 3) Concessions- Teresa

- First event will be December 11<sup>th</sup> and most menu items will be available, but limited number of each item
- Limiting to 3-4 volunteers in concessions at one time
- COVID safe practices will be in place with volunteers wearing masks, 6 ft distancing in lines, one window to order food and the other window to pick up food, new containers to better cover food
